ADOPTED RULES

CHAPTER 291. PHARMACIES

SUBCHAPTER A. ALL CLASSES OF PHARMACIES

§291.9

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.9 concerning Prescription Pick Up Locations. The amendments clarify that U.S. Mail is a type of common carrier.

SUBCHAPTER B. COMMUNITY PHARMACY (CLASS A)

§291.33

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.33 concerning Operational Standards. The amendments clarify a recordkeeping requirement for a donated prescription drug dispensed under Chapter 442, Health and Safety Code, in accordance with House Bill 4332.

CHAPTER 291. PHARMACIES

SUBCHAPTER G. SERVICES PROVIDED BY PHARMACIES

§291.133

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy proposed amendments to §291.133 concerning Pharmacies Compounding Sterile Preparations. The amendments, if adopted, update the personnel, environment, compounding process, cleaning and disinfecting, beyond-use dating, cleansing and garbing, environmental testing, sterility testing, recall procedure, and recordkeeping requirements for pharmacies compounding sterile preparations.
